**Archives: Busts and Paintings** 

In its Archives, the Library maintains busts and paintings of prominent leaders and members of the Society that were once displayed at its Horticultural Halls in Boston, Massachusetts. Ten busts and 45 paintings were moved to Elm Bank in 2000. Over the years, the Society restored the paintings as needed, most recently in 2002. On December 30, 1888, a fire at the second Horticultural Hall on Tremont Street severely damaged several of the paintings. All but two were restored; a full length portrait of Jacob Bigelow and a portrait of President William Gray, Jr. were destroyed. The fate of another painting of President Charles Wallingford Parker is unknown. Today, the condition of the objects varies. Some are in good condition, while others show signs of deterioration, particularly on the frames of the paintings.

Dearborn, and were displayed from top to bottom and progressed to the left around the room.
