### HERBERT W. GLEASON NEGATIVE COLLECTION

**This collection depicts large estate gardens in the Northeastern United States, photographed by Herbert Wendell Gleason in the early twentieth century.**

Herbert Wendell Gleason (1855-1937) was born in Malden, Massachusetts and graduated from Williams College and Andover Theological Seminary. In 1882, he moved to Minnesota to serve as a congregational minister. In 1899, when he retired from the ministry, he became a professional photographer and moved to Melrose, Massachusetts. Gleason worked as a photographer for the National Parks Service (NPS), *National Geographic* and other publications. He was close friends with the first Director of NPS, Stephen Mather, noted botanist Luther Burbank and the "Father of National Parks," John Muir. Gleason's particular interest in Thoreau is documented at the Concord Free Public Library—Special Collections. Later in life, he was the official photographer of the Arnold Arboretum and Massachusetts Horticultural Society (MHS) where he photographed its flower shows and other activities. Some of the images below, appear in MHS publications and were likely taken while Gleason was employed by MHS.

This Research Aid lists Gleason's annotations on his film wrappers. The information is cryptic and does not give the address of the properties. Most females were listed by their married name, *i.e.*, their husband's name, preceded by Mrs. While historically married women were known by their husband's names, it can be difficult to research their history. Further, identifying the owner of the property by the male birth and surname does not tell the full story since some of these women were owners of the property, creators of the gardens, and /or the person who managed the estate and who hired Gleason to photograph the gardens.

To augment the historical record and provide a more complete record of the past, the given and birth names of the women referred to on the wrappers are listed. The location, name and address of the property are added. Many of these places are no longer in existence, have changed names and/or owners. These additions should facilitate future research of these people and places.
