Collection: Busts and Paintings

The Society began to collect and display busts and paintings of its prominent leaders and members in 1861 to display in its Horticultural Halls. Ten busts and 46 paintings were moved to Elm Bank in 2000.

On December 30, 1888, a fire at the second Horticultural Hall severely damaged several of the paintings. All but two were restored; a full-length portrait of Jacob Bigelow and a portrait of President William Gray, Jr. were destroyed. The fate of the painting of President Charles Wallingford Parker is unknown. Today, the busts and paintings are in varying conditions. While some are in good condition, others show signs of deterioration. Portraits of General Dearborn, the Society's first President and Robert Manning, the Society's Librarian during its greatest period of growth and renown are hung in the Library at Elm Bank; the remainder are either on loan or in storage.

The portraits, arranged in chronological order by years served, started with the portrait of the Society's first president, General Henry A. S. Dearborn to the left of the library door (shown above at the end of the hallway.) They were displayed from top to bottom, progressing to the left.
